Knowing the ins and outs of a sewing machine will set you on the right path for any of your sewing projects. If you are new to sewing or need a refresher from using your Mom's machine years ago, this workshop will help get you on your way! Learn the parts and how to use a sewing machine including the bobbin, threading, sewing seams and tension difficulties. You will apply your new acquired sewing skill and make a shopping tote during this class!

Please note, the Sewing Machine 101 class or equivalent sewing experience is a prerequisite for our other sewing classes or drop-in + sew time at Spool of Thread.

## Drop-in + Sew

**\$8 per hour**  
(\$5 per hour without our machine)

Visit Spool of Thread with your sewing projects and work away at your own pace in our fully equipped sewing studio. Stitch at one of our 6 sewing stations complete with easy to use Janome sewing machines, or lay out your fabric and patterns on our large industrial cutting table. The hourly rental rate also includes use of other tools like irons and dress forms. To use the drop-in + sew time, you must have experience using a sewing machine.

Drop-in + Sew time is only available when a class or workshop is not scheduled in the sewing lounge. Please check our class listings for times.

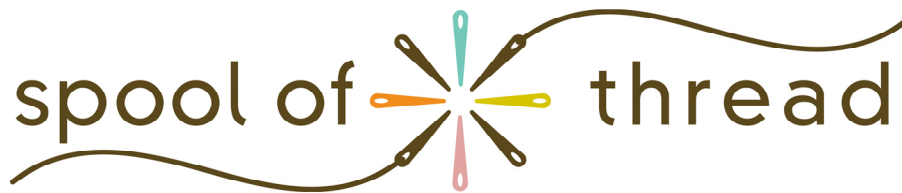
## Class Registration:

Classes at Spool of Thread are limited to 6 students for best instruction.

A minimum of 4 students is required for a class to run. Each student has full access to our sewing machines during class times. We require a 50% nonrefundable deposit to hold your seat in the class. If a class is canceled by Spool of Thread, your deposit will be fully refunded or the dollar amount applied to another class. Full payment is due on or before the class begins. Upon registration, we will email you a confirmation of your class along with a full materials list. Materials and supplies are not included unless otherwise noted.
